Mr. Fink was employed by the Investment Company Institute, the national association of the mutual fund industry, from 1971 to 2004, and served as the Institute's President from 1991 to 2004. He is the author of a history of mutual funds, *The Rise of Mutual Funds: An Insider's View*, published by Oxford University Press (second edition 2011). He regularly lectures at law and business schools, law firms, mutual fund boards, and other institutions. He is a trustee of the Committee for Economic Development and a member of the FINRA Investment Companies Committee. He serves on the board of the Oppenheimer Mutual Funds and as Chairman of its Regulatory and Oversight Committee. Mr. Fink is a graduate of Brown University (summa cum laude 1962) and Harvard Law School (cum laude 1965), and attended the London School of Economics.
